Katrina Foley Mayor, Costa Mesa & 2020 CA State Senate Candidate (D37)

In November of 2018, Costa Mesa voters chose Katrina Foley to be the city's first directly elected Mayor. Katrina also served as Mayor in 2016-2017, and has been on Council for 10 years, (2004-2010; 2014-2018). She previously served the public on the Newport Mesa Unified School District Board of Trustees from November 2010 to November 2014. **Katrina's focus is on making Costa Mesa better for families.** She has 2 college age boys who attended Costa Mesa Public Schools and is married to Casey Swanson, a local teacher and high school golf coach.

Katrina is President of The Foley Group, A Professional Law Corporation in Newport Beach. The Foley Group, PLC provides services in contract negotiations for artists and athletes, civil business and employment litigation, and non-profit compliance matters. In 2001 and 2004, Katrina was honored by Women in Leadership and the National Association of Women Business Owners' at the annual Remarkable Women Awards event.

Katrina is a proud graduate of Head Start, UCLA (BA – English), and Seattle University (Juris Doctorate) on a Dean's Scholarship. Upon graduating from law school, Katrina received numerous public service awards including the National Association of Women Lawyers 1996 Outstanding Woman Graduate and Washington State Trial Lawyers Association Public Service Award.

Katrina is dedicated to collaborating within the community to improve our neighborhoods, public schools, and maintain a prosperous and vibrant business community. Addressing the climate crisis, creating jobs, and improving public safety and the quality of our community are her top priorities. She has announced her 2020 candidacy for State Senate District 37. She has gone from a frightened little girl, a political refugee from Tehran, to successful businesswoman, parent, mentor, community leader – because her parents and her adopted country gave her a foundation and real opportunity to excel.

From a first time volunteer, she learned, worked and rose to positions with more and more responsibility. After the campaign ended, Melahat moved on and up, bringing her considerable negotiating and leadership skills to the job of Executive Director the Democratic Party of Orange County in 2007.

From that position, Melahat was able to take the ground that was being prepared and plant the seeds that grew into a beautiful blue "harvest" in the 2018 midterms. She oversaw the creation of things as diverse as a stable fundraising base to organized voter registration drives to recruiting an army of passionate activists, who joined with experienced organizers to do the essential work of voter contact and education.

She also agreed to take a seat on the Board of Planned Parenthood of Orange and San Bernardino Counties, consulting with the National Iranian-American Council and other community-based projects.

Melahat has also built a very successful full service political consulting firm, Progressive Solutions Consulting. She has recently expanded to include a division for public advocacy.

Her skills and work ethic have seen her win many awards, including recognition by the California State Assembly and the US House of Representatives, The John F. Kennedy, Jr. Award from the California Democratic Party for service to the Democratic Party, Orange County Young Democrats Mentor of the Year, and the Democratic Foundation of Orange County's Howard Adler Award for Excellence in the Art and Science of Politics.
