Endorsements & Nominations

This committee is responsible for vetting candidates for all elected offices seeking the endorsement of NBWDC. Candidates are required to submit a Candidate Questionnaire prior to being considered for endorsement. The Committee will review the candidate information and submit recommendations to NBWDC's **Board and membership**.

Through an established vetting process, this committee also submits a slate of NBWDC Officer Candidates to the NBWDC Executive Board for review and approval. The Executive Board then submits the approved candidates to the voting membership at the Annual Meeting.

Fundraising
